COURSE SNAPSHOT

Sleep Technology (Polysomnography) is the science of diagnosing and treating sleep disorders — insomnia, sleep apnoea (affects 11 crore+ Indians), narcolepsy, and restless leg syndrome. A Registered Polysomnographic Technologist (RPSGT) operates sleep labs, scores sleep studies, and assists physicians in treatment.

This is India's most niche paramedical field with a severe supply shortage. A trained sleep technologist can earn Rs. 60,000-1,50,000/month within 3-5 years. International demand (USA, UAE, Australia) is very high.

Qualification pathway: B.Sc. Respiratory Therapy / Cardiopulmonary Technology (3-4 years) + Sleep Technology specialisation certificate, OR dedicated diploma in Sleep Technology (1-2 years post 10+2 Science).

ELIGIBILITY

- 10+2 PCB minimum 45-50% for B.Sc. pathway.
- 10+2 PCB or PCM (some institutions) for diploma pathway.
- For international RPSGT certification: 1 year clinical experience in accredited sleep lab required post-course.

ADMISSION TIMING

- Most B.Sc. programmes: admissions June-August.
- Short-term diploma/certificate courses: rolling admissions throughout year.
- RPSGT exam (USA-based BRPT): registration open year-round, exam taken at Pearson VUE centres in India.

Where Sleep Technology is Formally Taught (India):

- AIIMS New Delhi — Sleep Disorders Clinic runs training programmes intermittently.
- NIMHANS Bengaluru — sleep research training.
- Christian Medical College Vellore (CMC) — sleep medicine fellowship.
- Apollo Hospitals Chennai/Hyderabad — in-house training programmes for sleep technologists.

- Manipal College of Health Professions — Respiratory Therapy (pathway to sleep technology).

For Western UP Students — Practical Pathway:

- Step 1: B.Sc. Respiratory Therapy from a nearby institution (GLA University Mathura, Sharda University).
- Step 2: Seek internship at any hospital with sleep lab — AIIMS Delhi, Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, Medanta Gurugram.
- Step 3: Appear for RPSGT international certification.

- BRPT (Board of Registered Polysomnographic Technologists) — USA. Website: brpt.org.
- A+ Sleep (India-based training): online + attached sleep lab training.

FUTURE PROSPECTS

India Domestic:

- Sleep labs in corporate hospitals: Apollo, Fortis, Max, Manipal — all expanding.
- Respiratory & Sleep Departments at AIIMS-type institutions — Group B/C Government posts.
- Home Sleep Testing (HST) services — growing home healthcare segment.
- CPAP equipment companies: Philips Respironics, ResMed — clinical support roles.

International (Outstanding Prospects):

- USA: RPSGT-certified technologists earn USD 55,000-80,000/year. H1-B visa pathway through hospital sponsorship.
- UAE/Saudi: Sleep lab technologist roles Rs. 2-3.5L/month, tax-free.
- Australia: Sleep technologist roles, PR pathway via skilled migration list.
- UK: AfC Band 5-6 NHS roles for qualified sleep physiologists.

- Agents promising 'direct USA job' post-diploma without actual work experience or RPSGT — BRPT requires documented clinical hours.
- Online 'certificate in polysomnography' without any hands-on lab component — worthless clinically.

HOW TO VERIFY YOUR COLLEGE

- ✓ BRPT official site: brpt.org — check eligibility requirements directly.
- ✓ For any B.Sc. programme: verify university UGC recognition at ugc.ac.in.
- ✓ Call the hospital sleep lab directly — ask if they accept training students and what credentials they recognise.
- ✓ NCAHP recognition for allied health programmes: ncahp.gov.in.
