COURSE SNAPSHOT

Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery Technologists assist in all OT procedures related to plastic, cosmetic, reconstructive, and burn surgery. They set up operating rooms, prepare specialised instruments (microsurgery sets, tissue expanders, skin grafting tools), and assist in post-operative wound care.

India's cosmetic surgery market reached Rs. 15,000 crore in 2024, growing at 18% annually. Burn centres and reconstructive surgery units are expanding across all tier-1 and tier-2 cities. This is a niche but very well-paid specialisation.

Qualification: B.Sc. OT Technology (3 years) with specialisation in plastic surgery, or B.Sc. Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery Technology (where available, 3 years).

ELIGIBILITY

- 10+2 PCB minimum 45-50%.
- Basic anatomy knowledge important — PCB background essential.
- Manual dexterity and attention to detail — surgeons test this informally.

ADMISSION TIMING

- Follows general OT Technology admission cycle: April-August.
- Specialisation usually declared in Year 2-3 of B.Sc. OT Technology.
- Short-term Plastic Surgery Technician certificates: available at Apollo, Fortis — rolling admissions.

- Safdarjung Hospital New Delhi — national burn centre, UP-accessible.

- Amity University Noida — B.Sc. OT Technology with optional plastic surgery rotation.
- Sharda University Greater Noida — linked to Sharda Hospital with cosmetic surgery unit.

- Apollo Hospitals Training Centres — in-house certification programmes.

Fee Range:

- Government: Rs. 8,000-25,000/year. Private: Rs. 70,000-2,00,000/year.

FUTURE PROSPECTS

- Cosmetic surgery clinics: Dr. Mohan Thomas Aesthetics, Kaya Clinic, DermaClinix — major chains.
- Burns units: government hospitals — consistent demand, cadre posts.
- Reconstructive surgery centres (post-cancer, post-accident, cleft lip/palate organisations).
- Medical tourism hospitals: JCI-accredited private hospitals catering to international patients for cosmetic procedures.
- Wound care specialist — emerging independent clinical role.

International:

- UAE/Qatar/Saudi: Cosmetic surgery industry booming — OT technologist roles Rs. 2-3.5L/month.
- UK NHS: Plastic surgery ODP (Operating Department Practitioner) pathway.
- Turkey: Medical tourism hub — significant demand for trained Indian technologists.

SPECIALISATION PATHWAYS

- Wound Care Specialist certification (WOCN, USA-based).
- Microsurgery assisting — requires specific training in specialised instruments.
- M.Sc. OT Technology with plastic surgery specialisation.
- Cosmetic dermatology assisting — laser technology, filler assisting certifications.

SCAM & PITFALL WARNINGS

- Fake 'Cosmetic Surgery Technician' courses from beauty institutes — not medically recognised; completely different from clinical OT work.
- Unlicensed aesthetic clinics hiring 'technicians' without medical supervision — illegal and dangerous; verify clinic has a registered RMP.
- Cosmetic companies selling 'botox technician certification' — administering injectables requires MBBS; do not accept such roles.
- Private colleges claiming specialised plastic surgery labs — visit and verify these labs exist before paying fees.

HOW TO VERIFY YOUR COLLEGE

- ✓ NCAHP for OT Technology programmes: ncahp.gov.in.
- ✓ UGC recognised university: ugc.ac.in.
- ✓ Verify hospitals: National Accreditation Board for Hospitals (NABH): nabh.co.
- ✓ Check if the attached hospital has a functional burn/plastic surgery unit (minimum 5 beds).
